Executive Summary:

I would like to ask the Board to adopt the attached Resolution approving the agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) for the High Risk Pest Exclusion in Lake County from July 1, 2021 through the June 30, 2022. The new agreement amount is \$11,047.94.

This is a state program that reimburses the Agricultural Commissioner's office for inspections plant shipment at distributions center like UPS, the Post Office, and truck shipments at local stores. This program is critical for Lake County agricultural because it prevents invasive pests and diseases from becoming established in the county.
