Executive Summary:

On June 7, 2022, the County of Lake Board of Supervisors approved an application form available to the public to be considered for a position in a Task Force to draft Article 73 of the Lake County Municipal Code Chapter 21 - the Zoning Ordinance. Article 73 will address the regulations and requirements for obtaining a conditional use permit for commercial cannabis activities.
