**SUBJECT**: (a) Consideration of Continuation of a Proclamation of a Local Emergency Due to the Sulphur Fire Incident; and (b) Update and Discussion on the Sulphur Fire Recovery

#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

- (a) A wildland fire known as the Sulphur Fire began in Lake County on October 9, 2017 at approximately 12:55 a.m., originating in the Clearlake Oaks area and progressing on to Clearlake and surrounding areas, destroying structures and burning 1800+acres. As a result of the occurrence of the Sulphur Fire, a local emergency was proclaimed by the Lake County Sheriff/Director of Emergency Services Brian Martin on October 9, 2017. The declaration needs to be re-considered and confirmed by your Board once every 30 days to stay in effect.
- (b) Staff will provide an update on the recovery status of the Sulphur Fire, which began in Lake County on October 9, 2017 at approximately 12:55 a.m., originating in the Clearlake Oaks area and progressing on to Clearlake and surrounding areas, destroying structures and burning 1800+acres.
