Executive Summary:

As your Board is aware, Jenavive Herrington, was recently elected to Auditor Controller/Clerk, and will be maintaining and broadening her skillset and contributions to meet current and long-term County needs.

The Auditor's Office is requesting approval to send Ms. Herrington to a training entitled "Accounting and Financial Reporting-Advanced Governmental Accounting." The course is designed for CFO/Finance Director, Controller, Accountants to learn and obtain updated information regarding specialized accounting and financial reporting used by state and local governments for selected topics through lecture, discussion, and exercises. CPE units will be earned during this training.

GFOA represents the entire United States and Canada. They are headquartered in Illinois, and these valuable trainings and conferences are oftentimes held in their offices. All efforts to reduce costs will be made.
